If you sell or give away this product, make sure you give this instruction to the new owner.

Children have died or been seriously injured when gates are not securely installed.


- ALWAYS install and use gates as directed using all required parts.
- You **MUST** install wall cups to keep the gate in place. Without wall cups, child can push out and escape.
- **STOP** using when child can climb over or dislodge/open the gate.
- Use only with the locking mechanism securely engaged.
- **NEVER** use to keep child away from pool.
- This product will not necessarily prevent all accidents. **NEVER** leave child unattended.
- Intended for use with children from 6 months through 24 months.
- This gate has an automatic close system.
- Do not use the safety gate if any components are damaged or missing.
- Ensure the surface you mount gate to is suitable for purpose and structurally sound such as solid timber, brick or masonry.
- For plaster/gyprock surface, locate the timber beam or stud behind and mount in this location (mounting on plaster/gyprock alone is not strong enough and not safe). Do not mount to glass.
- DO NOT install this gate to hollow walls.
- This gate is intended for indoor use and is not to be exposed to outdoor elements.
- Install this gate away from heaters and other sources of heat.

CAUTION:

With any pressure mounted gate, a construction bar is required across the base. Note, this bar can be a tripping hazard. If you choose to position a pressure mounted gate at the top of stairs, use extra caution to step over this bar to prevent trips and falls.

Can be used in conjunction with a Dreambaby[®] Watch-the-Step[®] Gate Ramp (F837) to help avoid tripping.

INSTALLATION


Measure the width of the opening of where you intend to install the gate.

For wider openings select the appropriate Gate Extension(s), sold separately.




Ensure the surface you are mount the gate is structurally sound such as solid timber, brick or masonry.

For plaster/gyprock surface, locate the timber beam or stud behind and mount in this location (mounting on plaster/gyprock alone is not strong enough and not safe). DO NOT MOUNT TO GLASS.






- 3. Screw Upper clamp into place using Z.








A maximum of 4 Gate Extensions can be used, 2 on each side of gate. Do NOT install 3 Gate Extensions on the same side of gate.

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

To Install, place the gate in the opening so that the bottom of the Gate Frame is completely flat on the floor (3A), and it is perpendicular to the openings and the floor (3B & 3C).







4. Fasten the Mounting Cups to the wall with screws or double-sided adhesive tape (4A & 4B). NOTE: Ensure that they are aligned vertically, so that the Mounting Cups at the top are directly above the ones at the bottom.



5. For use on stairs (5A & 5B).







Wood screws (J) included.

For Brick or Masonry use the appropriate fittings, screws and plugs for your wall (not included)


6 Insert the Bolts with Rubber Pads and Tension Knobs into the Gate Frame, then partially slide the Bolts with Rubber Pads and Tension Knobs outwards into the Mounting Cups (6A & 6B).






Tighten both of the bottom Tension Knobs by turning them at the same time (7A & 7B).

NOTE: Make sure the bottom of the gate frame remains completely flat on the floor. Next, tighten both of the Tension Knobs at the top at the same time by turning them (**7C**).




8 Tighten the Tension Knobs until the two Indicator Lines, located on the Upper Locking Set and on the Right Upper Corner, align horizontally (8A).



OPERATION


1 To open the gate:





2. To close the gate:

Release the Gate and it will swing closed automatically. Try this action several times and make sure:

- The Upper and Lower Locking sets are engaged (2A & 2B).
- The Warning Line has disappeared (2C & 2D).







MAINTENANCE & CARE

- Gate must be fitted according to instructions, to ensure it works correctly.
- Regularly check gate to ensure it is fitted properly and securely. Adjust as required.
- Regularly check tension knobs and rubber pads to make sure the gate is securely in place.
- Do not use the safety gate if any components are damaged or missing.
- To clean, wipe surface with a damp cloth or sponge using mild detergent and warm water. Never clean with abrasive, ammonia based bleach based or spirit type cleaners.
- If the gate does not stay in position or does not swing closed properly, the gate may not be installed properly. Remove and re-install gate, make sure the gate is installed vertically.
- Indicator Lines must be correctly aligned.
- Keep 1mm / 0.04in gap.
- Any additional and replacement parts should be obtained from Tee-Zed Products.
